The CBA basketball program has had a rich tradition of basketball success based, in large part, upon the tenets mentioned above. We are convinced that good things result when hard work and preparation meet opportunity. If you are a player interested in learning the game, a player who is not afraid to work hard and take instruction, then this is the camp for you.

The CBA basketball camp emphasizes those skills which will help you improve as a basketball player. There is a heavy emphasis upon drills designed to introduce each camper to the techniques which must be mastered in order to compete at the high school level and beyond. Games are usually played on the last day of camp after the entire week's instruction has been completed.

The camp staff utilizes the same teaching approach in the camp setting as they do in their daily in-season practice sessions.

Coach Doemel took over the reins of the Varsity squad in 1998 after successfully serving as coach at the lower levels since 1979. He is a strong believer in the team concept of play.

Doemel's teams have reached the Section II finals in each of the last 8 years and have captured five Section II Class AA titles. The 2009-2010 season was culminated with a New York State Championship. He has had the privilege of coaching some great players, most notably, Brian Monahan, Josh Duell, Joe Bova, Lucas Weaver, Greg Holle, & Malcolm Austin. Monahan and Bova were named as the Most Outstanding Player by many area media outlets in their respective senior years.
